Task Specific Safety Checks & Notes	Operational Checks
● In the first instance, please ensure you have referred to your site-specific Risk Assessments & Method Statements (RAMS) ● Working areas are to be segregated in accordance with MIDA Operational Standard - 2.4 - Segregation - General Working Area or MIDA Operational Standard - 2.6 - Segregation - Public Working Area ○ Wherever we are operating within trafficked carriageways, we must be working under Chapter 8 regulations	● Inform the Local Authority to let them know we are starting works – they may want to inspect ● Ensure all drainage has been checked and signed off prior to any wearing course being installed ● Is the benching complete? ● Are the manholes and drain lines clean? ● Check that all manholes comply with the specification: ○ No damaged biscuits or raising sections ○ Correct quantity of raising sections are installed?
