Task Specific Safety Checks & Notes	Operational Checks
● In the first instance, please ensure you have referred to your site-specific Risk Assessments & Method Statements (RAMS) ● Ensure local residents are forewarned of future works in a timely manner via letter drop ● Working areas are to be segregated in accordance with MIDA Operational Standard - 2.4 - Segregation - General Working Area or MIDA Operational Standard - 2.6 - Segregation - Public Working Area ○ Wherever we are operating within trafficked carriageways, we must be working under Chapter 8 regulations	● Inform the Local Authority to let them know we are starting works – they may want to inspect ● Has the necessary testing been booked – NDM's, RSE etc.? ● Have the adoptable drainage and manholes been inspected, checked, and signed off before works commence? ● Check the laying formation is suitable before commencing ● Check all carriageway and ironwork levels are correct as per the site-specific design ● Ensure that tarmac depths are as design – if not, regulate the areas in advance of the sub-contract works ● Check the material specification ● The area and works are to be pre- and post-dipped by MIDA Site Manager and Engineer with the sub-contractor ● Check Tarmac Requisition Process has been completed, "QMF 35 – Tarmac Requisition"

● QMF 32 – Pre-Wearing Course Inspection ● Binder course and ironwork to be surveyed pre-wearing course ● Check weather forecast is within adopting authority guidelines to lay and Back to Black Sweeper is booked ● MIDA Engineer to complete a full as-built survey post-wearing course – to be issued to MIDA Project Team ● Post tarmac level and quality inspection to be carried out by MIDA Site Manager & Engineer before signing off sub-contractor's work ● Copies of NDM test results are to be recorded at site level and issued to head office ● Photograph the completed area and include in your photographic daily diary	● MIDA Operational Standard - 2.4 - Segregation - General Working Area ● MIDA Operational Standard - 2.6 - Segregation - Public Working Area
