Objective	Application
● To safely provide storage provisions for small tools, equipment and materials ● Protection of MIDA tools, equipment and materials	● Sites where MIDA are acting as Principal Contractor and Subcontractor
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Responsibilities
● Container Surface – area to be stripped, levelled, constructed and compacted with 6F2 and plainings ● Containers: ○ Option 1 – MIDA Storage container to be placed on the ground ○ Option 2 – MIDA Storage container to be placed on firm level ground. MIDA Site office to be placed on top of the Storage container ● Signage – Externally the container should be identifiable by signage, internally the COSHH area should be identifiable ● Internal storage: ○ Shelving to be made up of timber for small tools, equipment and materials ○ Chain storage racks/areas constructed of timber are to be installed ○ Bunding/containment should be available for all substances i.e. oils/fuels	● COSHH – considerations should be made for the storage of COSHH items, which are to be suitably contained and ventilated. Additionally, the storage of fuels and oils which should be suitably bunded and ventilated. COSHH RA's should be available for all substances held within the container ● Security – the storage container is to remain locked at all times when unattended to prevent against unauthorised access. The container is to be secured by a key lock
