Objective	Application
● To store waste in good order, segregated and to achieve good standards of housekeeping ● To allow waste areas to be easily accessible and reduce double handling ● Positively maintain MIDA's brand	● Sites where MIDA are acting as Principal Contractor and Subcontractor
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Responsibilities
● Storage Area Surface – area to be stripped and levelled, size dictated by skip specifications ● Segregation – the waste storage area is to be secured by blue Heras fencing, placed on feet and double clipped to three sides and pedestrian fencing to the fronts ● Waste storage areas must be placed at least 10m away from a drainage system or watercourse ● Hazardous waste station to be segregated from other waste areas with suitable signage in place ● External Signage – waste storage area, groundwork only, skip signage boards are to be installed identifying the type of waste and SIC code ● Skip type – enclosed skips to be used as a primary option, size to be indicated on an individual needs basis	● Ensure skips are collected when full and replaced ● Do not overfill and store materials next to the skip ● Waste storage areas should be inspected by the Site Manager daily
