Objective	Application
• To provide safe access, egress and working areas for engineers when setting out • Provide clear communication and direction to engineers • Positively promote MIDA's brand	• Sites where MIDA are acting as Principal Contractor and Subcontractor
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Instructions
• Stockpiles – are to be assessed by a competent person to determine stability and use of proprietary or designed access equipment • Access/egress – stripped, levelled, compacted and steps to be formed in the ground. Where required proprietary access systems such as portable staircases can be utilised • Segregation – linked red & white post & chain barriers and red hooped gates to be located at access/crossing points • Signage – engineers setting out area, no unauthorised access	• Access to setting out areas must be restricted to engineers • Stockpiles and proprietary access equipment to form part of the temporary works register • Access equipment be inspected weekly (PUWER) and arrangements updated as required
