Objective	Application
● To segregate groundworkers only working areas from other trades ● To segregate infrastructure works from plot works ● Provide clear communication and direction to pedestrians ● Positively promote MIDA's brand	● Sites where MIDA are acting as Principal Contractor and Subcontractor and MIDA segregation is required to large working areas
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Responsibilities
● Segregation – the general working area is to be secured by blue Heras fencing, placed on feet and double clipped ● Access/egress – controlled by double leafed access gate for plant/HGVs and separate pedestrian access gate leading to internal walkways or pods ● External Signage – groundworker only, no unauthorised access ● Internal Signage – pedestrian walkways, thumbs up, pedestrian and plant crossing points	● Working areas are to be pre-planned and reconfigured as per the programmed works ● Fencing to form part of the Temporary Works Register ● Signage and fencing to be inspected weekly and updated as required
