Objective	Application
● To segregate groundworkers' working areas from the general public ● Provide clear communication and direction to pedestrians ● Positively promote MIDA's brand	● Working areas with a public/highway interface
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Instructions
● Segregation – the general working area is to be secured by interlinked hi-visibility chapter 8 road barriers, with weighted road ballast (mandatory on Street Works). Where Heras panels are utilised for Street Works water filled slot block heras feet must be deployed ● External Signage – groundworker only, no unauthorised access and pedestrian directional signage as required	● All barriers and signage to be compliant with Safety at Street Works and Road Works Code of Practice ● Working areas are to be pre-planned and reconfigured as per the programmed works ● Signage and fencing to be inspected daily and updated as required
