Objective	Application
● To segregate groundworker only working areas ● Post-works to segregate completed works created by MIDA Groundworkers that pose a risk for moving plant/motorists and potential drowning risks ● Positively promote MIDA's brand	● Where bulk excavation works and ponds are formed
Site Setup Instructions	Operational Instructions
● Segregation – the general working area is to be secured by Heras fencing, placed on feet and double clipped. Fencing to pond areas should be installed where a risk of drowning or directed by the client ● Access/egress – controlled by double leafed access gate for plant ● External Signage – groundwork only, no unauthorised access, warning deep excavation/warning excavation, deep water risk of drowning keep out	● Segregation isn't required where there aren't any other trades that interface our works ● Life buoy ring to be sited beside ponds once constructed to prevent drowning ● Fencing to form part of the temporary works register ● Signage and fencing to be inspected weekly and updated as required
