- Review and revise this policy statement as necessary at regular intervals, which shall be at least annually.

We are committed to providing the necessary time and resources to allow for the correct management of health and safety risks. This is achieved by providing the required training to individuals with health and safety responsibilities and allowing time within the normal working day to undertake health and safety duties.

Our internal Health and Safety Management System has been designed and implemented to meet the requirements of the ISO 45001: 2018 standard and is continually internally audited. Additionally, the combined Business Management System (BMS) is also externally audited by our appointed UKAS Awarding Body to the ISO 9001: 2015, ISO 14001: 2015 and ISO 45001: 2018 internationally recognised standards.

This policy statement is regularly monitored to ensure that the stated objectives are achieved. It is reviewed annually and, if necessary, revised in the light of legislative or organisational changes.
